Congratulations! I am pleased to inform you that the Arts & Cultural Council for Greater Rochester has approved your application for a 2014 Decentralization Community Arts Grant. Your grant is provided by the Arts & Cultural Council for Greater Rochester through support received from the New York State Legislature and the New York State Council on the Arts. Based on the recommendations of the Grant Review Panel, you have been awarded a grant of **\$2,686, contingent on the Arts & Cultural Council's receipt of funding from the State of New York.**

In order to receive funding, all grant recipients must schedule and attend a contract signing meeting at the Arts & Cultural Council offices, 277 N. Goodman Street. We will be following up with you to schedule this shortly. At the meeting, we will review key components of the Cultural Services Agreement that you will enter into upon acceptance of the grant.
